ROBERTSON, MOZELLE LACY - Mozelle Lacy Robertson, 93 from Sandy Hook, Connecticut died peacefully January 6, 2008 at home surrounded by her family and close friends. She was predeceased by her childhood sweetheart and loving husband Towns Bozeman Robertson. Mrs. Robertson is survived by her daughter, Emily Cassidy and her husband John; four grandchildren, Catherine Cassidy, Shannon Cassidy, Stacy O'Boyle and her husband, Jay, Sean Cassidy, and his wife Virna; three grandchildren, Katie & Jack O'Boyle and Tessa Mae Cassidy. Mozelle was born in Toccoa, Georgia on February 8, 1914 and was the youngest of 8 brothers and sisters. She worked as a hairdresser for 33 years and retired at 65 to take care of her ailing husband. After his passing, she continued to live in Georgia for another ten years, during which she was very active in her church women's group with many of her friends. She also had a very green thumb and loved to tend to the many flowers and plants she so enjoyed. She traveled to Hawaii at age 75 and 6 years later, at the age of 81, took a wonderful trip to China with her dear friend, Elizabeth Pugh. In 1996, she moved to Sandy Hook, Connecticut to be closer to her immediate family. She maintained her own home at Walnut Tree Village for 9 years, where she made new friends, became active in Newtown's Congregational Church, often working in the clothing recycle; and she continued with her hobby of gardening by lovingly tending to her beautiful backyard garden. She entertained several visits from close family members and longtime friends from Georgia and kept in constant touch with many of

her friends from the South. Last year her childhood friend of 84 years, Vera Loftin, visited for a week. The two spent a wonderful week together, catching up on old times and many fond memories from their past. In 2005, when she could no longer be on her own, she moved in with her daughter, Emily and son-in-law, John also of Sandy Hook, Connecticut. Mozelle was the quintessential "Southern Lady" and a true Georgia Peach. She will be lovingly missed by all who knew her. The family would like to extend their heartfelt thanks to all of the friends and neighbors and members of her church who treated her so kindly.
