JOSEPH - Patricia Ann (Willis) Joseph, age 78, of Lawrenceville, Georgia, passed away peacefully on Monday, April 21, 2025. Born on February 27, 1947, in Evansville IN, Patricia was the second oldest of six children. Patricia eventually found her way to Georgia making Lawrenceville her home. 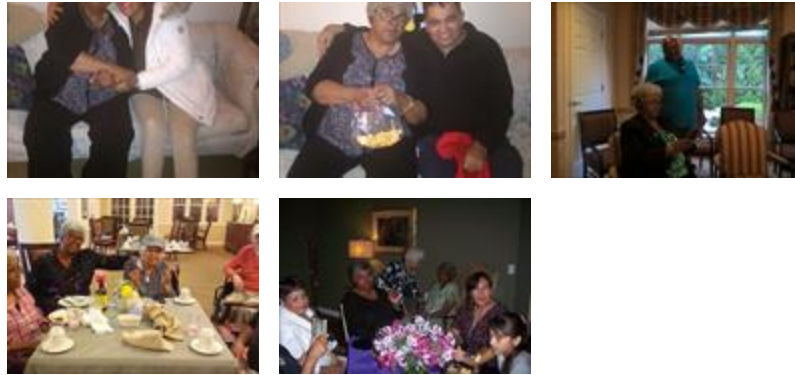
