Fenneran, Patrick John - Patrick John Fenneran, 39, of Loganville, Georgia died Sunday, June 6th, 2010 after a year-long battle with Leukemia. He was born March 27, 1971 in Neshanic Station, New Jersey. Patrick's family moved to Central Florida when he was 7. He graduated from Lyman HS in 1989, proudly served his country as a US Marine, and received his BS and MS in Cell and Molecular Biology from the Florida Institute of Technology, before relocating to Loganville in 2003. Patrick worked for the Center for Disease Control, founded the Loganville 4th of July Parade, was an active member of Grayson UMC, the American Legion, an avid cyclist, an unsung hero and follower of God. Patrick is survived by his wife and soul -mate Sharon Cataldo Fenneran, children Riley Elizabeth (7) and Conner William (5). He is also survived by his brothers Frank, Shawn, and Jeff Fenneran and the Cataldo-Clan sisters. The family will be receiving visitors Thursday, June 10, 5-8 PM at Grayson United Methodist Church.
