But they were close enough that my upsetting Dianne might upset Patty, and probably the same for David. So, both David and I may have had our hides rhetorically tanned on more than a few occasions.*

*Then there was the gifting. Each year, Dianne and Patty exchanged packages to celebrate birthdays and Holidays. David and I benefited, too, so we must have some redeeming qualities unless it was pity! Patty consistently sent Dianne Elvis junk (I mean memorabilia). *Dianne and I both cherished the times we were able to visit with Patty and David, as well as the daughters, husbands, and their children, which, in hindsight, were far too few. Of course, this is not that unusual in the world we now live in, but it is sad. Still, we have the memories which she wants us to celebrate now.*

*To Patty: Once you have become accustomed to your wings and the new and incredible home, please tug on our toe gently. You will already know how much we love you and how much we miss you. Also, put in a good word for us often. And, finally, when you see Elvis, don't forget to mention how much of a fan your soulmate sister is. Until we are reunited, watch over us!*

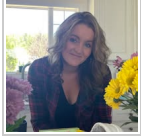

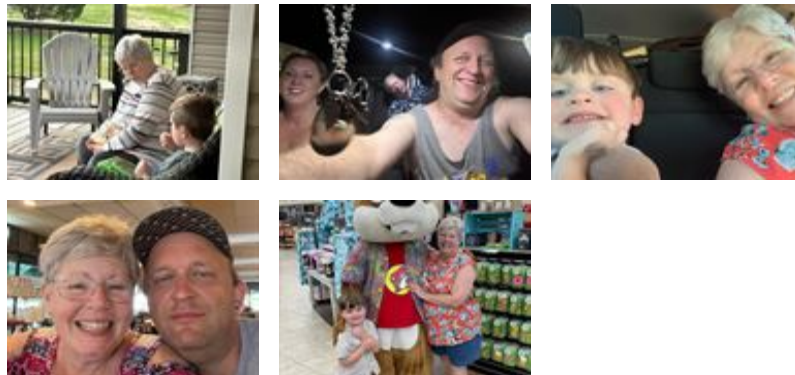

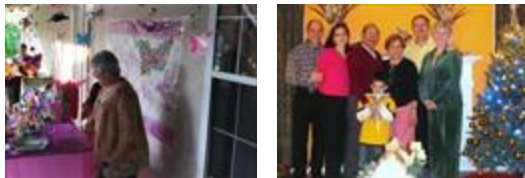
