Paul David Montgomery, 81, of Dacula, Georgia, passed away on Monday, April 7, 2014. He was preceded in death by his parents, Rev. Mencie and Hattie Montgomery, his wife of 55 years, Barbara Hildenbrand Montgomery, and his grandson, Luke Morgan Montgomery. He devoted more than 40 years of his life to Christian education; he retired as the manager of the BBN radio station in Winder.
