SMITH - Paul Smith, age 74 of Loganville, GA, passed away on Wednesday, October 8, 2025. He is now with Jesus in his new heavenly home and his totally healed body. A Memorial Service will be held at 3:00 PM on Sunday, October 19, 2025 at First Baptist Church Loganville with Pastor Jimmy Wilson officiating. The family will receive friends 1:30 PM - 3:00 PM prior to the service at the church. Paul was employed by BellSouth for 31 years. He also worked full time with the Gwinnett County School System for 10 years and 13 years as a substitute teacher with the Special Education classes. He served as a Deacon at Bethany Baptist and First Baptist Loganville for many years. Paul was a member of his church choirs and a former member of the Gwinnett Choral Guild. He was a Boy Scout Leader and was very involved with his community. Paul volunteered with the Special Olympics, mentored high school boys, was active in the "Path Project" for elementary students in Gwinnett County, was a member of the City of Loganville Concerned Citizens, and also helped with the Shiloh Marching Band. He was a big fan of the Georgia Bulldogs, holding season tickets for over 25 years. Paul also served in the National Guard. He was preceded in death by his parents, Jim and Dot Smith; sisters, Linda Davis and Pat Holly. Surviving is his loving wife, Vicki Smith; son and daughter-in-law, Ryan (Tricia) Smith; grandchildren, Ella Smith and Isaac Smith; many nieces and nephews.
