Lloyd “Pete” Jensen, Jr. passed away February 14, 2021 from complications of a broken hip and dementia. Pete was born July 15, 1936 in Camden, NJ to Lloyd Sr and Vincie Jensen, both deceased. He attended Moorestown High School in NJ where he met Mary Bugno, his future bride. He was a Second Lieutenant in the New Jersey National Guard for twelve years before moving his family to Chamblee, GA in 1966. He was employed by Kinney Vacuum Company for over twenty years, selling industrial vacuum pumps. In 1982, he started Jensen Engineering Sales Company, a regional industrial vacuum pump service company. Thinking about retirement, he and Mary built a second home in Cedar Key, FL which they enjoyed for many years. Pete was a friend to many, the life of any party, and he would tear up a dance floor whenever he had a chance.

Pete suffered from dementia for almost a decade and the family is grateful that he is at peace and no longer in pain.
