Pete made the best grilled cheese sandwich in the state of Georgia. He was a notoriously picky eater, and he never finished his last bite of food. Later

in life, his grandson taught him to enjoy Panda Express. Pete began working when he was 12 years old and was a jerk, a soda jerk. He served in the National Guard, worked in retail and was convinced by Allen Hood to join him at Hood Insurance Agency. Over a 50 year insurance career, Pete built a successful business based on helping people. He was known for his kindness and patience with his clients. He was well respected in the industry and in the local business community. He was proud to work with his son, P.K. Martin IV; daughter, Anna Martin Parker; and nephew, Jason Powell. Working with his family was one of his greatest joys. Pete loved Jesus. He was a long-time usher at Hebron Baptist Church. Later he attended Ebenezer Baptist Church in Harbins, Georgia. He enjoyed fellowship with old friends and new. In his difficult battle with cancer he clung to his faith and spent a lot of his free time reading his Bible. 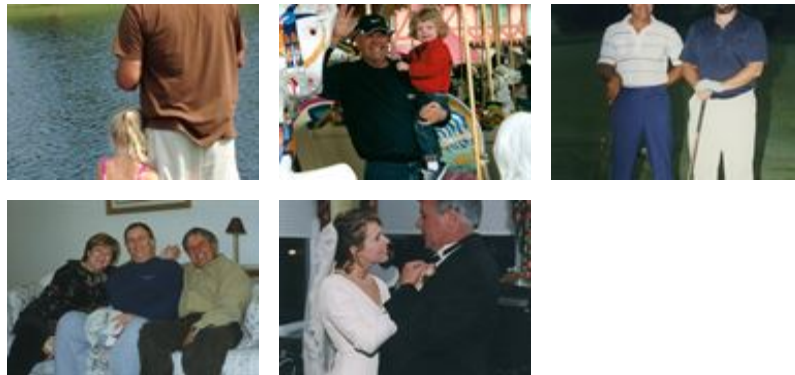

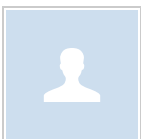
