Philip Jones, age 49, was born in Atlanta, GA, in 1957 and lived in Snellville GA most of his adult life. He was employed by the State of Georgia. Philip was a highly skilled Software Systems Programmer Technical Lead for the Georgia Technology Authority (GTA) supporting system level software that resides on the State's IBM mainframe environment. His expertise was in support of online systems and networking.

Philip began his career with the State as an Applications Programmer with the Department of Administrative Services (DOAS) in 1983, where he wrote and supported application systems for the Department of Revenue. In 1986 he expanded his career by accepting a position with DOAS as a Software Systems Programmer supporting the State's online systems software which housed the majority of the State's online application systems. In 2001, Philip began work with the Georgia Technology Authority (GTA) when GTA absorbed support of the State's centralized computing environment. Philip quickly advanced to the top of his field as a Technical Lead in support of mainframe systems software. In addition, he was a highly skilled web developer, and developed web applications to provide information regarding mainframe enhancements and upgrades to customers of GTA. Philip was like a family member to many of his co-workers. He was a great friend and a truly caring man who will be dearly missed. The technicians across State Agencies who worked with Philip on technical issues or projects knew him as a dedicated and skilled technician, always willing to help out in any way he could, often

going above and beyond everyone's expectations. Not only will his dedication and his technical skills be missed, but many will also miss the quick wit and sense of humor he brought to even the most mundane of tasks. Philip achieved a Bachelor of Science degree from Emory University. Philip is survived by his fiancée Rhonda C. Hester of Roswell, four brothers and their wives, three nieces, and two grand nephews.
