Raju Varughese was born on May 25, 1956 in Thiruvalla, Kerala, India. He was the oldest son of T.M. Varughese and Aleyamma Varughese. He grew up surrounded by loving parents and had two siblings, Raji Varughese and Rajani Eipe. Being ten and fifteen years older, he was a large influence in both their lives both by helping them as children and then by setting the example for how they should live their lives as they grew older. He first joined the Indian Army when he was 17 years old, and was stationed throughout India during his career. He worked as an electrical and mechanical engineer where he was responsible for the upkeep of the military vehicles. He was respected by his peers and those he led. He continued to serve the Indian Army for 25 years until he immigrated to America. On May 16, 1983, when he was 28 years old, he was married to Molly Varughese and started a new chapter in his life. Soon after he had two children, Remya and Reema. He was a devoted father and husband who was a great role model and taught his children how to keep their faith even through life's trying times. Raju immigrated to America with his family in June of 1998 where he started a new life in a different country. He worked hard throughout his life to support his family and give his children everything they needed as they grew older. His family grew larger in 2009 when Remya was married to Joshua Hathaway, and again in 2013 when Reema was married to Joice Mathew. In 2014 his first grandson, Elim, was born, soon followed by another grandson, Josiah, in 2018. He loved nothing more than seeing and playing with both Elim and Josiah whenever they came

to visit. Raju's love of travel started during his career in the Army, and throughout his life he loved to see new places. He was a huge fan of Malayalam movies, especially comedies. He often could not be heard laughing, but his entire body could always be seen shaking with enjoyment. His favorite types of music were Hindi songs and Malayalam hymns. He was a dedicated Christian and faithfully attended multiple congregations throughout his life, including Atlanta Marthoma Church for the last 22 years. Raju will be missed by all those who knew him and loved him. He leaves behind many wonderful memories and an amazing legacy.
