He later discovered a love for dirt-track racing and spent years at the local tracks in Winder and Athens, where he won even more trophies and was named "Driver of the Year" on more than one occasion. 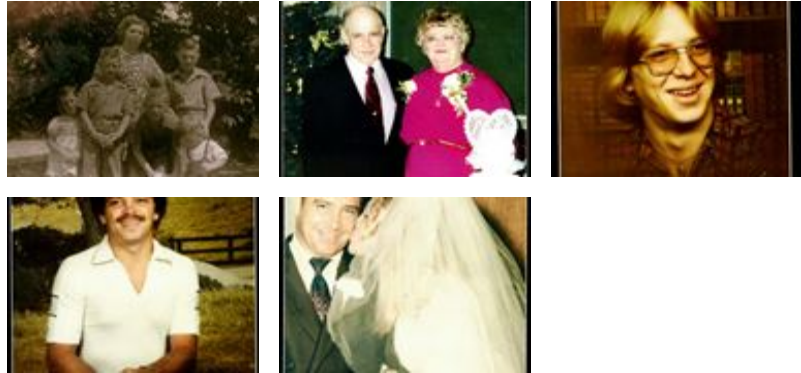

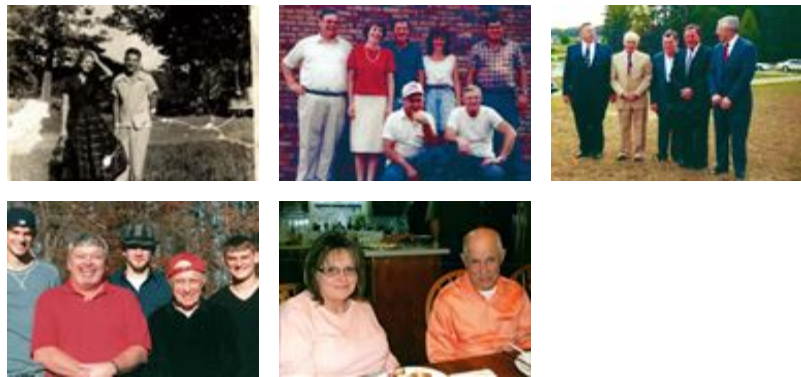
