BROWN- Raymond "Red" Brown Sr., age 95 of Lawrenceville, GA, passed away on Sunday, December 7, 2014. A Funeral Service will be held at 3:00 PM on Tuesday, December 9, 2014 at Central Baptist Church in Lawrenceville, GA. Rev. Tim Tanner will officiate. Interment will follow at Gwinnett Memorial Park in Lawrenceville, GA. Mr. Brown was born in Newnan, GA in 1919 and moved to Chicopee Village, GA in 1925. Red played football and baseball at Gainesville High School and went on to play Minor League Baseball in the Georgia-Florida League. Mr. Brown was an Army Veteran and served in WWII during the European theatre in the Battle of the Bulge. In 1950 Raymond moved to Lawrenceville and worked for Southern Bell for 36 years before retiring. He and his family are charter members of Central Baptist Church in Lawrenceville, GA. He was a member of the Lions Club, a Charter Member of Greater Lawrenceville Athletic Association, and a 30 year member of the Central Gwinnett HS Athletic Association. He is survived by his wife of 68 years, Evelyn Turk Brown; children: Josie Baker of Dacula, GA, Raymond, Jr. (Sonny) and Glenda Brown of Lawrenceville, GA; five Grandchildren; eight Great Grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.
