Miller – Reed Miller age 84 of Dacula passed away on Saturday, August 15, 2020. A funeral service will be held 11:00 AM, Friday, August 21, 2020 in the Lawrenceville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home, with Pastor Steve Carroll officiating. A private burial will be held at Georgia National Cemetery in Canton, GA. Mr. Miller was an U.S. Army Veteran, former Mayor and City Marshall for Dacula, GA. Mr. Miller was a retired Chief of Police for the city of Chamblee, GA. At the age of 26 he became the youngest police chief in the state of Colorado, serving the community of Commerce City CO. He was the first detective hired in Gwinnett County in 1968, serving in law enforcement over 50 years. He was a member of Dacula Church of God. He was preceded in death by his loving wife of 56 years, Aggie Jane Miller in 2011; and son, Charles Miller in 2014. 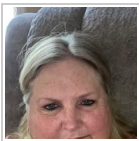
