Retired Army Colonel, Wayne C. Harrington, age 92, of Social Circle, Georgia, passed away on May 14, 2025. Wayne was born in Oneonta, NY on January 3rd, 1933. A Funeral Service will be held 1:00 PM on Tuesday, May 20, 2025 in the Monroe Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home with Pastor Mike Hardy officiating. Entombment will follow at Hill Haven Memory Gardens, 490 Edmondson Road, Monroe, GA 30656 with full military honors. Wayne served his country honorably in the United States Army with 32 years of service, receiving multiple medals, including the Silver Star and Purple Heart. He served a tour of duty during the Korean War and two tours of duty during the Vietnam War as a member of the Army Special Forces. After retirement Wayne owned and operated B&W Boating and later was the Commander of the American Legion Post 332 in Social Circle dedicating many years to serving veterans. He was an avid outdoorsman who liked to hunt, fish, pan for gold in Montana and hunt for ginseng in New York. He also enjoyed working in his garden and spending time with family. Wayne was preceded in death by his parents, Clifford and Pauline (Gregory) Harrington and brother, Paul Harrington.
