Hayes – Rev. Ollie V. Hayes, age 86 of Lawrenceville, passed away peacefully on Saturday, August 22, 2020. A graveside service will be held 11:00 AM, Wednesday, August 26, 2020 at Mulberry Baptist Church Cemetery, Hoschton. Ollie V. worked at Abrams in Atlanta for many years before being called to serve as a Baptist minister.
