Winfrey – Dr. Gene E. Winfrey age 90 of Loganville, passed away Thursday, February 7, 2013. A funeral service will be held 11:00 AM, Monday, February 11, 2013 at Corinth Baptist Church, 3156 Langley Road, Loganville, GA 30052, with the body placed in state at 10:30AM. 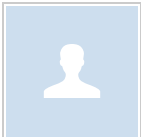
