Rickey Lee Harrison, 67, of Loganville, GA passed away on October 16, 2021 from complications of heart failure. 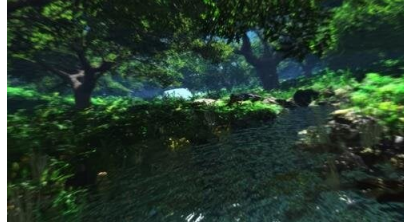

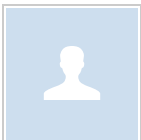
