About eight of us had a club at my home on Coquina Key that entailed bike tag at Boyd Hill Nature Preserve, bike figure eights in the street (followed by repair session), tree tag, War (dart gun teams), and whatever sport we chose to engage in. Once Bobby was pitching to me and I had his catcher's mitt that I was not familiar with. As I lowered it across my face the ball was right there and I wore the "fat lip" for several days. Amazing how after all these years I can still hear the smack and recall the numbness where you are afraid to see the actual damage. Teeth all there. We shared many sleepovers and birthday events, but not being able to get to sleep after "Shock Theater" sticks in my memory most. And Dot's stuffed cabbage and holiday cookies. We were all in shock at the sudden loss of Steve, just as we all are now four decades later. I remember the morning and telling our teacher why Bobby was not in class.
