WILDER – Robert (Bob) H. Wilder age 98 1/2 of Cartersville, Georgia passed away Wednesday, April 8, 2026. There will be a visitation Monday, April 27th at 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM at Tim Stewart Funeral Home in Lawrenceville, a short graveside service following at the City of Snellville Cemetery at 11:30 AM, and a service and time of remembrance at 3:30 PM at the Cartersville First Baptist church. Bob was born on August 6, 1927 in Oakfield, New York, and was blessed to live a long life. He married Doris (Boyd) of Toledo, Ohio, and there they raised their 3 children. Carol (Dan) Qualman is now in Parker, CO, Gary (Marlene) Wilder is in Litchfield, MN, and Sandra (Paul) Rose is in White, GA. They were married 63 years until she passed away. Bob spent the majority of his working years in the food sales business selling everything from coffee to pickles to steaks for restaurants and other food establishments. For a short time in their early married years, he and Doris owned a greenhouse where Bob grew flowers and made arrangements for weddings and funerals. Bob enjoyed planting and caring for gardens of both flowers and vegetables his entire life. He took great pride in being able to grow some of Doris' favorites. Bob had a love for flying and would often take family members up for rides. Another of Bob's fun activities was making wooden toys. What started as 'tinkering' with wood soon became a successful side business. Bob would do the cutting, Doris would do the sanding, and together they would sell the wooden toys at craft fairs and trade shows. Their retirement years saw them travel to all 50 US states and Canada in various

types of RV's, 5th-wheels, and travel trailers. A highlight was renewing their vows to celebrate their wedding anniversary in Alaska while part of a camper caravan. In later years when Doris became ill, Bob was determined to care for her at home and never complained about their travel times ending. It was important for him to continue learning his entire life. He spent time reading and took many online educational courses. Bob was preceded in death by wife Doris, granddaughter Tiffany Rose, brothers Horace and Bernie, sisters Virginia Wilder (Dunlap) and Lucille Wilder (Smart), and parents Horace & Elsie (Bowden) Wilder. Bob is survived by the children, 8 grandchildren, 17 great grandchildren, numerous in-laws, nieces, and nephews. The family would especially like to thank the WillowBrook Hospice Group and all the staff at Manor Lake Assisted Living in Cartersville, GA for their dedication and love of Bob and going above and beyond to care for him. 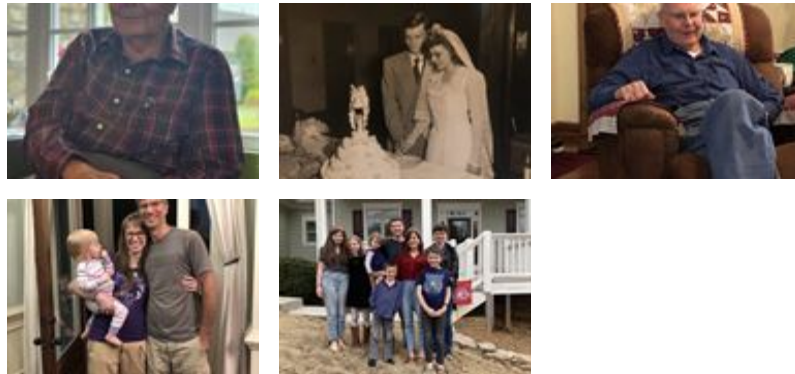
