



## Robert Bruce Clark

June 14, 1923 - October 18, 2011

Robert Bruce Clark, 88, a 78 year resident of Bradford, Pennsylvania, and the last ten years a resident of Dacula, Georgia, went home to his Lord and Savior on October 18, 2011 in the Gwinnett Medical Center after heart failure. He also suffered from prostate cancer and Alzheimer's disease. He was loved and respected by his family and will be greatly missed by his many devoted friends. He was born on June 14, 1923, served in the United States Marine Corps from 1943-1945 where he was awarded the Purple Heart ribbon, the Presidential Unit Citation ribbon, the American Campaign medal, the Asiatic-Pacific Campaign medal, the World War II Victory medal, the Marine Corps Sharpshooter Rifle badge, the Honorable Service lapel button and the Marine Corps Honorable Discharge button.
