ALEWINE – Roy Jerry Alewine “Papa”, age 85 of Loganville, went home to be with Jesus on Saturday, August 28, 2021, surrounded by his family. He was born to Joseph and Susie Alewine on January 28, 1936 in Augusta, GA. He graduated from Richmond Academy and Georgia Southern University. He was a member of the National Guard and was inducted into the Georgia Southern Baseball Hall of Fame. He spent most of his career in the insurance industry. 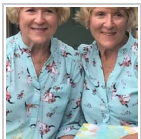

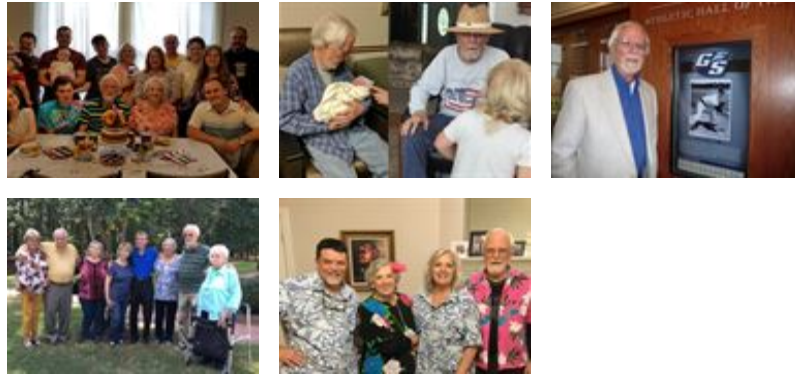
