Wallis- Roy D Wallis, age 92, of Monroe, formerly of Lawrenceville passed away on Thursday, July 21, 2016. Funeral Services will be held at 2:30 PM on Sunday, July 24, 2016 at Pleasant Grove Baptist Church. Rev. Scott Cramer & Rev. Ben Wallis will officiate. Interment church cemetery. Mr. Wallis was a WWII Veteran of the U.S. Army's Americal Division, 182nd Infantry; He was wounded in the invasion of Cebu Island, Philippines, in March, 1945. Mr. Wallis was awarded the Purple Heart & Bronze Star. Roy, besides being a farmer, was a master carpenter, building houses for many years for Fortenberry Brothers, then as an independent contractor. He built many homes throughout Gwinnett County. He also worked for Gwinnett County Board of Education Maintenance Department.
