*I did some checking and found John C Linder b 22 Jun 1852 d 17 Dec 1904 & wife Mollie C Linder b.04 Sep 1859 d, 26 Aug 1939 buried at Northview in Hartwell. Hart Co Marriage is listed as 29 Dec 1887 the bride's name is Mrs Mollie Swillings. The 1900 Census list the family as married 13 years and having 5 children; 4 are listed. This is the only John Linder found. My Dad talked about the Linder family; they had river bottom land and a corn patch that was more than a mile long. You could plow all day and only get a few rows done!!*

*It's late night so will close for now. I do my best work in the wee hours. I have a good bit of information on your family and will email you a copy later; I hope you will find it interesting.*
