



Ruth Ann (King) Summers

Ruth Ann Summers passed away peacefully and surrounded by family on September 1, 2024, at the age of 94. She was born and raised in Weakley County, Tennessee, and was predeceased by her husband of 70 years, Thomas M. Summers, and her parents, Edward T. King and Mary C. King. 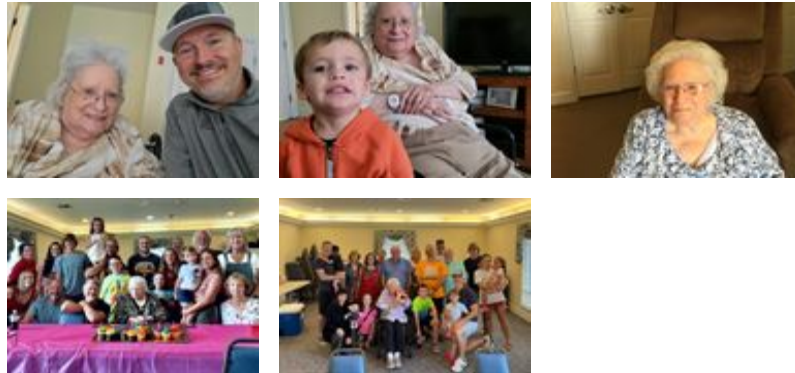
