“ Shirley and I had some good times. I remember Mr. Watson getting two horses, one huge white horse and one regular size black. They were both beautiful. I loved the white one, sitting on him bareback was like sitting on huge feather pillow. He used to rear a lot, with the slightest touch on his bit. I loved it! I was thin and bony in those days. Shirley and I only rode horses together a couple of times. I do have many fond memories of riding my horse, Bob, to her house and having snacks Mrs. Watson served us while we were bumming around. As I remember, at least twice, Bob got tired of being tied to a pine outside, took his bridle off and went home. Mama and Daddy would open the gate and let him back in the lot. They did not know where I was so I would have to call them when I went out and found my transportation gone.

Later in life, not soon after I got my drivers license, I was driving down a street near the Watson Dealership. A new truck came into the street to my left and crashed into my car, two guys, laughing and not paying attention to driving. Long before cell phones, I went to the radio station and asked the lady there to please call my parents. As I was walking out the door, she said 'be sure to write down their license plate'. They gave me a name and phone number and they left. Those turned out to be false but they had mentioned to me something about Mr. Watson's dealership. When I told my Dad that, he called Mr. Watson to ask if he had any idea who those men were. Mr. Watson recognized the plate number and said they were on a test drive of one of his vehicles. He took care of everything and the damage to my dad's vehicle was repaired. Thanks to that lady working at the radio station for looking out for a very young new driver and forever thanks to the Watson family.
