REED - Thomas Eville Reed, 87, of Loganville, GA died February 7, 2017. He was born in Fort Pierce, FL, one of three children of William Henry and Mildred Marsh (Jackson) Reed. He was educated in the Fort Pierce public schools and later attended MIT. In 1952, he was married to Shirley Sapp in Fort Pierce, FL. They have three children.

Mr. Reed is a military war veteran having served in the Army during the Korean Conflict. Mr. Reed moved to Cambridge, MA to attend college at MIT then later moved to Sudbury, MA. He began working at MIT while still a student in 1957 as an electrical engineer. He continued to work for Charles Stark Draper Laboratory when the company separated from the MIT Instrumentation Laboratory.

Once retired he moved to Charlton, MA where he became involved in local politics, serving on several boards and committees. He was a regular volunteer for both the local 4-H club and the region's donkey and mule association. He later moved to Goffstown, NH and finally to Loganville, GA. He is survived by his beloved wife Shirley; his son Arthur L. Reed and wife Lydia Krutchkoff Reed of Carefree, AZ; a son William W. Reed and wife Virginia Maily Reed of Northborough, MA, and a daughter Debra Kovac and husband Steven Kovac of Loganville, GA. He also leaves a sister Janet Pettit of Palatka, FL. He also leaves 3 grandsons; Zachary Reed, Harrison Reed and Philip Kovac. He is survived by several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by a brother, William Jackson Reed.
