TRIPPE – Thomas Terry Trippe, Jr., age 92 of Canton, Georgia, passed away on Sunday, January 14, 2024. A Funeral Service will be held at 11:00 AM on Friday, January 19, 2024, at Berean Baptist Church, 1405 Hewatt Road, Lilburn, GA, with Rev. Danny Sweatt officiating. The burial will be held at Parkway Memorial Gardens, 720 Carl Vinson Parkway, Warner Robins, GA. Terry was born in 1931 in Randolph County, GA. After being a dedicated church member since the age of 12, Terry gave his heart to Christ when he was in his twenties. He received both a Bachelor of Science degree and 3 Master of Education degrees; one in Education, a second in Guidance and Counselling and a third in Administration. Terry worked for the school systems of Houston County, Bibb County and Macon Christian Academy. He was instrumental in founding Macon Christian Academy in Macon, GA and Berachah Christian Academy in Huntsville, AL; serving as principal of each school. Terry continued in Education Administration until he retired in 1996. He then began to visit mission fields all over the world and later, became a Sunday School teacher. Terry was an avid fisherman all his life, but throughout his life God led him not just to be a fisherman, but a Fisher of Men. He was preceded in death by his wife, Ruth Marzelle (Deese) Trippe. He is survived by his daughter, Susan Trippe, Flowery Branch, GA; son and daughter-in-law, David & Shannon Trippe, Canton, GA; daughter, Debra Trippe Kahl, Flowery Branch, GA; daughter and son-in-law, Terry Lynn and Kim Allen, Queen Creek, AZ; grandson and granddaughter-in-law, Clinton &

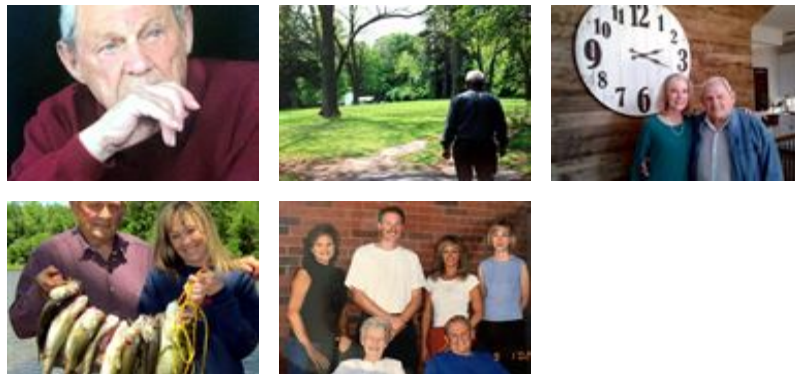
