February 28, 1958 - May 11, 2023

MONTGOMERY - Dr. Timothy L. Montgomery, age 65 of Dacula, Georgia, passed away on Thursday, May 11, 2023. A Funeral Service will be held at 3:00 PM on Sunday, May 28, 2023, in the Stewart Funeral Home Chapel in Lawrenceville, Georgia. Prayer: Rev. Frankie Sutherland, Rev. Cecil Ash, Rev. David Martin, will officiate. Prayer by Rev. Scott Martin. Eulogy by Dr. James Brett, and Dr. William Seanor.

Dr. Montgomery was an active Deacon of Appalachee Baptist Church for 35 years until present. He was a 1976 graduate of Winder Barrow High School, also being an FFA member all four years, and an officer several years. He was 1983 graduate from the University of Georgia College of Veterinary Medicine. He held many positions in organized veterinary medicine, including being the State President of Georgia Veterinary Medical Association. He along with Dr. Jim Brett were responsible for writing and getting the Georgia Veterinary Practice Act passed at the state capital, along with facilitating and writing the cruelty to animal law, and getting it instated as a felony. Dr. Montgomery was holding the house National delegate position the longest from Georgia for 17 years with the American Veterinary Medical Association. Dr. Montgomery was active in the National Political Action Committee for Veterinary Medicine, and held several positions in PAC. He held a Dacula City Council seat from 2005 -2012. Dr. Montgomery and his wife Leslie are the

owners of Dacula Animal Hospital. He was preceded in death by his son, Michael Clayborne Montgomery, and his parents, Leon Hinton and Mattie Irene (Morgan) Montgomery; his in-laws, Rev. Louis Carl and Helen (Sells) Fowler; and his brother-in-law, Laran C. Fowler. Dr. Montgomery is survived by his wife, Leslie (Fowler) Montgomery, Dacula, GA; daughter Miranda Megan Montgomery Dacula, GA; her fiancée Brandon Lee Robinson, Kennesaw, GA; sister, Judy (Ray) Fowler, Monroe, GA; brother, Emory (Cynthia) Montgomery, Dacula GA; and brother-in-law Louis (Teresa) Fowler, Dacula, GA.
