Mr. Farrell was a devoted husband & loving father and will be greatly missed. Born in Chattanooga, TN on March 21, 1949, he spent his early years growing up in Woodbury, CT, attending local schools there. In 1972, he received his B.A. from Lynchburg College in VA, & in1980, a Law Degree from Western St. University. In 1981, he was admitted to the Georgia Bar U.S. District Court, Northern District of Georgia, and the U.S. Court of Appeals, Eleventh Circuit. Immediately following his admittance to the Georgia Bar, he opened a private practice on Crogan Street in Lawrenceville. Most recently, his office was located on Constitution Blvd. For the last three decades, he has enjoyed practicing law in the areas of domestic relations, personal injury, & workers' compensation. A well respected member of the legal community, Mr. Farrell was regarded as one of the outstanding attorneys of Gwinnett County. Mr.Farrell was a member of the Atlanta & Gwinnett Co. Bar Associations &

served as treasurer of the Family Law Division of the Gwinnett County Bar Association. His love of law often found him volunteering time with high school Mock Trial Competitions. He was a faithful parishioner of St. Lawrence Catholic Church. Mr. Farrell was especially fond of spending time at home with his family, playing with his dogs & working outdoors. He was an avid Georgia Bulldogs fan, & a vintage car collector with membership in the North Georgia Thunderbirds Club. Mr. Farrell was very active in local & state politics. A patron of the arts, especially the performing arts, he provided a memorable stage performance in Atlanta Opera's production of Verdi's masterpiece, Aida. He was also the owner & president of the Commons Associates, Inc. in Lawrenceville.
