Todd Mitchell Graham was born in Lawrenceville, Georgia to Billy and Gail Graham on April 16, 1964. He was a graduate of North Georgia College where he received a degree in Business Administration and commissioned into the US Army Reserves as a 2LT. He was a Gulf War Veteran, in which he served in Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Noble Eagle, and served in Kuwait. He earned many medals during his service. He earned 3 Bronze Service Medals, Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Meritorious Unit Commendation, National Defense Service Medal, War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Southeast Asia Service Medal, War on Terrorism Service Medal, Armed Forces Reserve Medal, Army Service Ribbon, and Kuwait Liberation Medal. He retired as a Major after serving 21 years for his country. He loved his country and was honored to be a soldier and a veteran. He later earned his masters in Public Health, and was employed at the CDC in Atlanta. When he was not serving his country or honoring other veterans Todd was enjoying his Harley Davidson motorcycle. He enjoyed many rides through the North Georgia Mountains.

He leaves to cherish his memories: his wife Jennifer (Hootman); his son Trevor Mitchell Graham, his mother Gail Graham, his sisters Kelley Kilpatrick (Bryan) and Tabitha Fister (James), sister in laws, Jill Hootman, Judy (Mark Tunnell) brother in law John B Hootman and a host of nieces, nephews and many friends.
