MILLS, TOMMY -LCDR Thomas A. Mills USN (Ret), age 44 of Snellville, GA., died Saturday, February 10, 2007 following an 8 ½ year battle with Brain Tumors. Funeral Mass will be held 11 AM Tuesday, February 13, 2007 at St. Oliver Plunkett Catholic Church, Snellville. Father Jim Henault will serve as Celebrant. Burial will be held at 3 PM Tuesday, at Georgia National Cemetery, Canton, GA. A F-14 Navy Fighter Pilot, Mr. Mills retired with 13 years of service. He was employed with BellSouth for the past 7 years. He was a 1980 graduate of Tucker High School and a 1985 graduate of Auburn University. He was a member of St. Oliver Plunkett Catholic Church.
