Turner - Victor (Vic) Paul Turner, 68, of Lilburn GA went to his eternal home in Heaven on February 20th, 2024. Visitation will be held from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM on Saturday March 9, 2024, at Tim Stewart Funeral Home in Lawrenceville. Vic was born in Chicago and raised in Sanford, Florida. Vic proudly served in the United States Navy during The Vietnam War. He was a successful businessman in the world of telecommunications, proudly earning his RCDD Certification. He achieved recognition in the Marquis Who's Who Book for his expertise in broadband. He loved to ride his Harley and was a walking encyclopedia always open for in-depth historical conversation, unmatched in Trivial Pursuit and rarely stumped when watching Jeopardy.

He is survived by his devoted wife of 46 years, Sherry Turner; his children, Chris, Erik, Jeremy and Audra; his son-in-law Brian and daughter-in-law Andrea; his brothers Scott (Robin), Gary (Geneva) and David (Michelle); his 13 grandchildren, whom he dearly loved, Kieran, Leland, Noah, Kyle, Emily, Matthew, Alyssa, Alexis, Dahlia, Remi, Caden, Sebastian and Kathryn; and one great-granddaughter, Madeline.

He is preceded in death by his father Bill, and stepmother Mary, as well as his mother, Juanita.

Vic eagerly underwent a series of elective, corrective spinal surgeries, the first of which was performed on August 22, 2023. Over the past 6 months, there

were additional surgeries, major setbacks, and absolute, God-given miracles. He consistently overcame the setbacks and surprised the medical staff at both Piedmont and at The Sheppard Center. Dad worked his tail off to regain his strength and to heal. The ups and downs led him deeper into his relationship with Christ, to a place where his faith was stronger than ever, and he loved with a heart more like Jesus. He is remembered affectionately by his entire care team.

He stood tall and had significant relief from chronic pain that ailed him for many, many years. His time was certainly cut way too short, but we believe he experienced joy in having his chin held high.
