



Walter Marshall Brandenburg

February 26, 1920 - August 20, 2015

Walter Marshall Brandenburg of Monroe went to sleep peaceably here on earth on August 20, 2015 and awoke in his heavenly home. Born in Augusta, Georgia in 1920, he was the youngest child of the late Perry Emmitt Brandenburg and Nina Rush Brandenburg. He is also predeceased by his wife of 67 years Mary Durden Brandenburg and his daughter Frances Brandenburg. Shortly after the bombing of Pearl Harbor, Marshall enlisted in the Army Air Corps. While home on leave in November 1943 he married Mary Nelle, the love of his life. In October of 1949 he and Mary Nelle adopted their two children and spent to rest of their lives teaching, providing for and loving their children, their grandchildren and their great grandchildren. Marshall is survived by his son Pat Brandenburg, grandson Patrick (Donna) Brandenburg, granddaughter Lena (Tim) McKnight, great grandchildren Billy and Casey Brandenburg, Hunter and Sterling Yarbrough, and his friend Mona Beavers.
