



## Walter Crosby Hobbs

June 4, 1942 - October 11, 2021

Walter Crosby Hobbs, age 79, passed away at home on Monday, October 11, 2021, after a lengthy battle with cancer.

Walt was born on June 4, 1942, in Milton, MA, near Boston. His parents were the late Ruth Sargent Brock and William Jarrett Hobbs. He often told his family and friends about the fun Saturday nights where the Hobbs, Brock and MacNeveins families would get together, eat 'brown bread' and beans, and sing songs around the piano played by his Uncle Stan and Grandfather.

Walt grew up in the same community as his mother and even had some of the same teachers as his mother had at his age (he told us that 'he could not get away with anything.'). In 1961, he graduated from the New Hampton College Prep School in New Hampton, NH and in 1965 graduated from Wilmington College in Wilmington, OH.

Shortly thereafter, Walt moved to Rochester, NY where he began his career working for Rochester Telephone. After 18 years, he moved to Cortland, NY with Rotelcom Supply and in 1984, he moved to Atlanta with Contel Material Management Company. He retired in 1993. Retirement meant more time to spend with his boat, the Indeed, on Lake Lanier, golfing with his buddies, woodworking (including construction of Adirondack chairs and other artistic items for friends and family) and visiting with his family on the 'Cape'. Walt and Judy enjoyed traveling to Florida, Maine, Cape Cod, and Italy, along with spending many fun weekends on the lake.

Walt was a great son, father, husband, and friend. He is survived by his loving

wife, Judy, along with his three children, Amy (Phil) Graham, Chris (Tracy) Hobbs, and Jarrett (Jennifer) Hobbs and six grandchildren (Sarah, Jack, Ben, Hayden, Addison, and Brooke) and his extended family, Andy Jewett, Paula Voorhies (Bill), Nathan Jewett (Gayna), and Jason Jewett (Courtney) and seven grandchildren (Ben, Luke, Ian, Hallie, Jacob, Lily, Lana, and Hunter). He is also survived by his aunt Katherine Stoia of Cape Cod, several cousins, his sister, Martha Hobbs, and brother, Bradford Hobbs, of Braintree, MA. He will forever be missed by family and friends.

The Celebration of Life service for Walt will be held on Saturday, November 6, at 2:00 pm at St. Matthew's Episcopal Church in Snellville, GA. Family will receive guests in the Fellowship Hall after the service.
