CLEGG - Warren Clegg, age 83 of Monroe, died Saturday, September 27, 2008. Funeral services will be held at 10 AM Monday, September 29, 2008 at St. Alban's Episcopal Church. Rev. Brent Owens will officiate, and interment will be in Rest Haven Cemetery. Mr. Clegg was a WW II pilot in the Air Corps. He was a civic leader and a member of St. David's Episcopal Church in Lakeland, FL. He built and operated the most modern dairy of its time. He was an honorable man.
