KELLEY - Wayne C. Kelley, age 73 of Snellville, passed away on Friday, August 21, 2020. A Memorial Service will be held 11:00 AM, Saturday, September 5, 2020 in the Snellville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home, with Rev. Allison Per-Lee officiating. Mr. Kelley was a U.S. Army Veteran, serving during Vietnam where he received 2 Bronze Stars. He was an extreme advocate for his fellow Veterans. He dedicated his life to their cause. He touched so many Veteran lives, which included organizing annual military reunions and trips to congress. Mr. Kelley was the published author of "Vietnam's White Orange Blue Rain Agents and Weapons of Mass Destruction". He worked at Rockwell International, developing the Hellfire missile that is on the Apache helicopter today. He was an amazing man, husband, father, grandfather and friend. 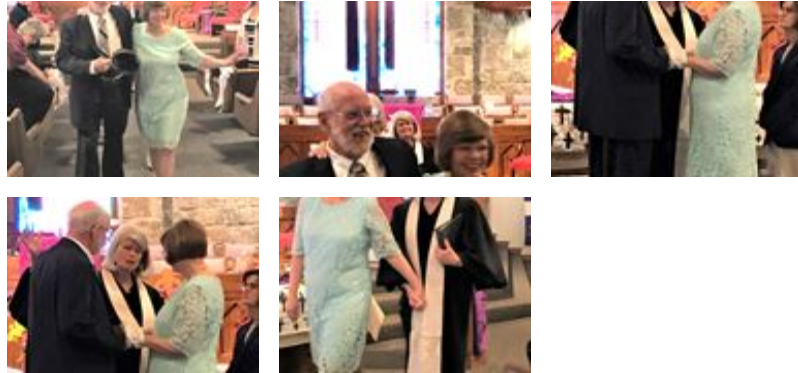
