REED- The Reverend Wayne L. Reed, 77, of Grayson, Ga passed into the Lord's presence at his home on February 2, 2025. A memorial service will be held at 2:00 PM on Tuesday, February 18, 2025, with a visitation prior at 1:15 PM at Tim Stewart Funeral Home Lawrenceville, Ga. After graduating from South Houston High School in South Houston, TX, Wayne earned degrees in Psychology & History from the University of Houston. Upon graduation he enlisted in the military & served his country honorably as an Army Ranger with 101st Airborne in Vietnam. During his tour he was awarded the Combat Infantryman's Badge, Silver Star, Bronze Star with Valor, an Army Commendation with Valor, the Vietnamese Cross for Gallantry with Gold Palm device, Presidential Unit Citation & Valorous Unit Citation. He also received the Purple Heart with an Oak Leaf Cluster. Wayne was an avid fly-fisherman and enjoyed woodworking and had a lifelong passion for learning. After his military discharge he obtained an Accounting Degree from Georgia State University in Atlanta, Ga. After 20 years in the Finance Division with The Coca-Cola Company in Atlanta he retired to answer God's call on his life for ordained ministry. He then obtained his Master of Divinity degree in 2003 from Emory University Candler School of Theology in Atlanta and served in the ministry as a Pastor until his retirement in 2017. He continued in God's service sending online prayers/devotionals to hundreds of recipients until the day of his death. Wayne and his continued devotion to his calling will be greatly missed by the many people whose lives he touched and influenced. This

He is survived by his loving and devoted wife of 53 years Judith Reed; brother Gordon & Janet of Pasadena, TX; and sister-in-law Sandra Chewing of Grayson, Ga.
