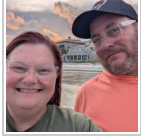
“ Outside my family there are less than a handful of people who helped shape me into the man I am today. Bill is the first person on that list of people. I would not be the man I am today without the time and energy that Bill invested in my life. I will be grateful to him for that gift for the rest of my life.

I was young when I knew Bill, but he talked to me and treated me like my words had weight. He cared about the questions I asked and listened when I thought I knew better. I remember one night at AWANA I had a question and I went to Bill for the answer. I can't remember what the question was, but I never forgot his response. He said, "I don't know, but I'll find out" (I think that was the first time an adult admitted to me that they didn't know something lol) I was taken aback, and he noticed. He pulled me aside and went on to explain the importance of admitting when you don't know something instead of just trying to answer. He also explained the importance of putting in the effort to find the answer, especially if you are expected to know, especially if you are going to be a leader. The next week I had already forgotten that I asked him a question at all, but he didn't. He came ready and prepared with the answer.

I remember the class trips into the woods, the pulling our socks over our pants, the eating ants and learning about poison oak. But I also remember his wisdom, his patience, his genuine care/concern, and his unashamed love for the lord.

Bill Alger helped shape my life, he will never be forgotten.

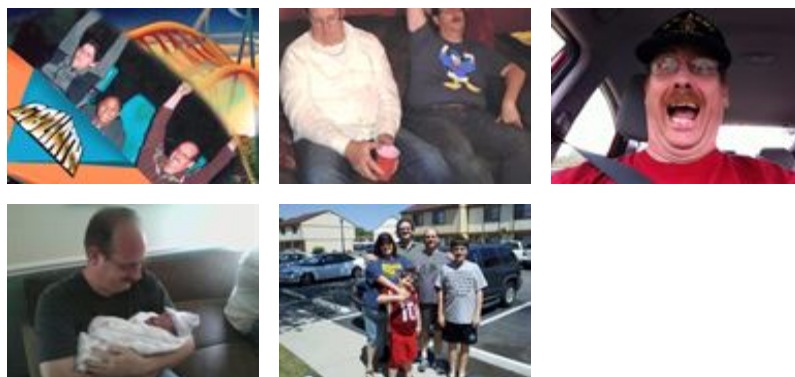
