LUX- William (Bill) Joseph Lux, was born on September 23, 1940 in Kittanning, PA to Joseph and Wanda Lux. After serving as a Sergeant in the Army, he was discharged from Fort Benning, GA, in 1967 and adopted Atlanta as his home.

A talented musician, he began playing the organ at St. Mary's Church in Ford City at the age of 12. After coming to Atlanta, Bill spent over 20 years singing with the choir at Christ the King Cathedral. In addition, he was the first music director for Holy Spirit Catholic Church in NW Atlanta, as well as the music director for Temple Sinai in Sandy Springs.

The majority of his career was spent teaching social studies in both middle and high school in DeKalb County, with his last position being at Open Campus.

His greatest love in life was his family. He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Dianne, and their three children - David Lux, Amy Amorose (Tony), Kevin Lux (Cheng), Daughter in Law Jennifer Lux, and his three grandchildren - Alex, Jackson and Spencer, as well as his sister - Carol Coleman (Tony).

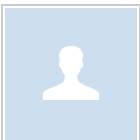

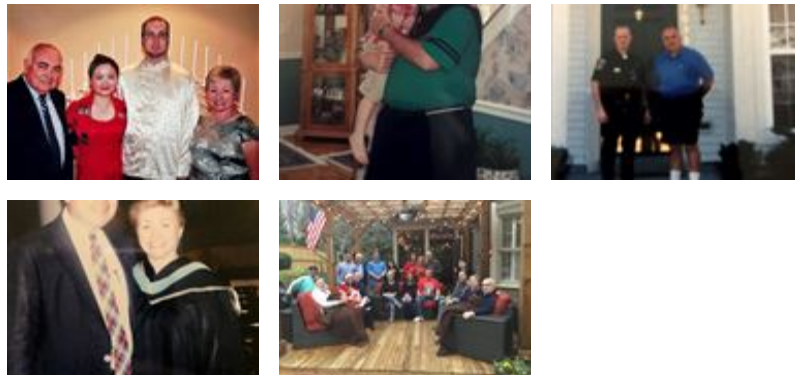
