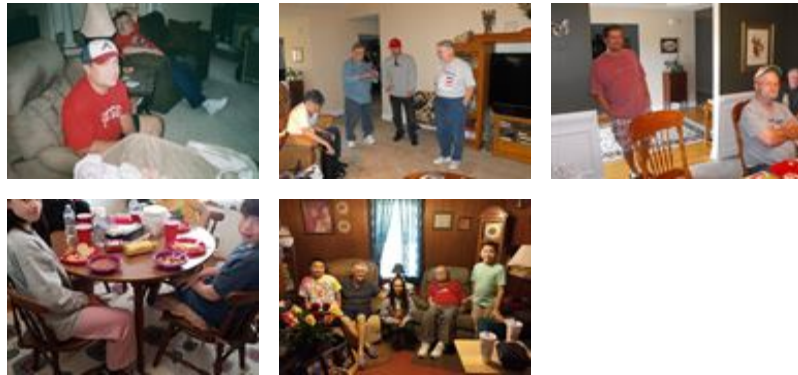

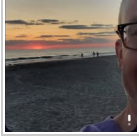

“ *My Daddy went home yesterday morning. I am extremely grateful that I was able to see him Thursday evening, tell him I love him, and say goodbye. His condition wasn't clear that night or would be over the next several hours, but I had a very strong feeling at the time that I was saying *the* goodbye to my Daddy.*

Yesterday, I was summoned out to Gwinnett County Hospital (Northside Gwinnett these days). While I was driving from Marietta, I knew that I would arrive just before or sometime after he passed. Turns out it was the latter.

For the second half of that drive, I couldn't help envisioning my Daddy approaching Grandmother and Granddaddy (his parents), Nanny and Papa (Mama's parents) and Mama's brother and sisters (all of Daddy's siblings are still with us) on the shores of the Jordan. I selfishly miss my Daddy, but I know that he's the happiest he's ever been now. And Mama and me will see him again soon. Don't get me wrong, I probably have another good quarter century or more in me, but 25 years is still only a moment through eternal lenses.
