*I am very sorry to hear of Bill's passing and that I am unable to attend his viewing. May God comfort you and your family. I will add you to my prayer list.*

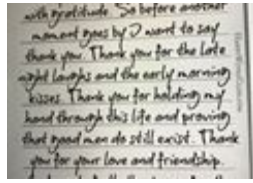
