Long – William Dean Long, age 89, of Lawrenceville, GA, passed away on Friday, February 9, 2018. Dean was born in Girard, Georgia. He graduated from the University of Georgia (UGA) in 1950 after attending Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College (ABAC) for 2 years. He was a World War II United States Army Air Corp Veteran who was recalled to active duty with the Air Force during the Korean War. Dean held many jobs during his working life. Among them were for the Georgia Extension Service, the Georgia Development Authority, and Standard Oil. He retired from the US Treasury Department, where he worked for 48 years before his retirement in 1996. Dean and Mary Frazier married in 1950. Surviving are his wife: Mary Long; Sons and Daughter-in-Law: Bill & Lynn Long, Victor & Ashley Long; Grandchildren: Jaletta & Andy Smith, Maggie & Eli Long; Great Grandchildren: James & Thomas Smith. Dean, Mary, and 1 son are University of Georgia graduates. Memorial Services will be held 2:00 PM Sunday, February 11, 2018, in the First Baptist Church of Lawrenceville Chapel on South Clayton Street in downtown Lawrenceville. Mary and Dean joined this church in the Chapel in 1951. Mary's parents and her siblings were members of this church.
