



William H. Rauschenberg Jr.

RAUSCHENBERG – William Henry Rauschenberg, Jr. 88, of Snellville, formerly of Sandy Springs, passed away on September 29th. Bill, a native Atlantan, was born October 12, 1929, and was a graduate of Georgia State University (then Georgia State College), obtaining a Bachelor of Business Administration degree in 1958. He later earned certification from Chartered Property & Casualty Underwriters (CPCU) and in Risk Management. During his 58-year career in the insurance industry he held national offices with CPCU and with the Professional Insurance Agents Association (PIA), and was a past president of the Georgia CPCU. He was also a member of Independent Insurance Agents (IIA). During his 19 years with Oberdorfer Insurance Agency he incorporated a risk management approach to commercial insurance, and later, up until his retirement, he spent 17 years with the firm of Hamilton, Dorsey, Alston. Bill was held in high regard and recognized for his true dedication and integrity in all that he did. In addition to his many years in the insurance field, he served 27 years in service to his country in the National Guard, initially in the Army Guard, then later, in the Air National Guard, achieving the rank of Lt. Colonel by his retirement.

Bill led a life of religious devotion and stewardship, serving in many capacities over the years at various churches he attended, most recently as a member of Holy Cross Anglican Cathedral in Loganville, where he particularly enjoyed participating in fellowship with The Brotherhood of Saint Timothy.

In addition to his parents, Bill is preceded in death by his sister, Helen Ponder. He is survived by his loving and devoted wife of 71 years, Frances, nee Braswell; son and daughter-in-law, Bill Rauschenberg and Diane Sesti; daughter and son-in-law, Christine and George Durgan; grandchildren, Brian wife, Cristy; daughter-in-law, Terri; Laura, Karl, Cathy, husband, Nate; and David. Great grandchildren, Matthew, Caroline, Ethan, Melanie, husband Jonathan; Brooklyn, Callie, and great-great granddaughters, Danielle, and Margaret.
