Wilma's outstanding service, however, was performed at her home in Plainsboro, NJ (a few miles from Princeton) where for a quarter of a century she befriended and entertained hundreds of her husband's Princeton Seminary students at picnic suppers and scores of other students at evening social gatherings marked by exciting games and exotic desserts. Wilma will always be remembered as a woman of a strong vibrant faith and a love for others that knew no ethnic or racial bounds. She will always be cherished as a faithful wife and devoted mother.
