“ Rodney...Tammy...Courtney...Baily...all family and friends: Far away from the dusty roads of Raleigh and southern Illinois this tragedy unfolded, and Zach is gone. I have remained here in southern Illinois near the roots of the tree of Bishop. The house Bernie and Nita lived in so long, a place where generations of this family gathered, is now owned by a young couple whose child I delivered not long ago. It's a small world. It seems to me that Zach, Courtney, and Baily should be running around that yard in swimsuits on grass wet with pool water spilled doing things in the pool that were not supposed to be done. Bernie, Nita, my parents, and members of America's greatest generation should still be sitting in the screened in porch off the garage, telling us their own true stories about the great depression, World War II, and why we should be our best selves. The garage remains, but the porch is gone as are most of that generation. Human reality is that our lives are fragile, and much of our world is temporal. But there are parts of our lives with permanence--our Maker, our family, our friends. These things matter. I know that there is nothing I can say to lessen or even completely acknowledge your loss. It is right to bring laughter into the lives of those around you, and Zach, much like his father, seems to have done that, usually by unorthodox methods and means.
